

## Dress Code



The Music Ministry is perhaps the most visible of all ministries at Legacy Church. Our job is to set an atmosphere of praise and worship to God. Our outward appearance must therefore be a reflection of our inward hearts. Isaiah 61:10-11 tells of a bridegroom and bride, adorned for a wedding. Our outward appearance must bring glory to God, and not detract from our musical message.

Although the dress code is not a "heaven or hell" issue, we must maintain a standard of excellence and professionalism on the platform. Members of LC Music Ministry are expected to dress with dignity and in good taste, refrain from wearing clothing, makeup, or accessories that detracts from our message or draws unnecessary attention.

### Men:

- Dressy, "business casual", or "smart casual" appearance is desired. Keep it sharp!
- Suits and ties are not required, but either a jacket, tie, vest, or sweater is encouraged.
- Clothes should be clean, pressed, and neat.
- No tight clothing, no suggestive writing on clothing.
- Flip-flops are not appropriate.
- Hair should be neat and style should not draw attention.
- Any jewelry or accessories must be minimal, modest and not draw attention.
- Every week there is a team "colors list", all members are expected to try to wear those colors. When you cannot wear those colors, all black should be worn.

### Women:

- Dressy, "business casual", or "smart casual" appearance is desired. Keep it sharp!
- Suits, pant suits, jackets and long tops are encouraged.
- Clothes should be clean, pressed, and neat.
- Low cut tops are not appropriate. Shirts must cover midriffs even with hands raised.
- Skirts must be at least mid-knee and not dragging the floor. Any slits must be modest.
- No tight clothing and NO underwear lines, no suggestive writing on clothing.
- Your selection of bra is an absolute must, as we do not want to draw attention during our celebration and dance. Cleavage is unacceptable!
- You may wear open toed shoes as long as your feet are manicured. Prefer more of a "dressy sandal", but NO flip-flops!
- Hair should be neat and style should be free from distraction.
- Make-up should be neat. You may want to apply a little extra due to the lights. Although it's not a must, color adds to your expressions.
- Jewelry and accessories must be modest and not draw attention.
