



Legacy Church Music Ministry

Member Requirements & New Member Process

Thank you for your interest in serving the Lord as part of the Legacy Church Music Ministry. To maintain the integrity of this ministry, certain membership requirements must be followed by each member. The main requirements are outlined below, along with an explanation of our application process for new members.

All members of the LC Music Ministry are expected to:

- Be a believer in Jesus Christ and have confessed Him as Lord and Savior of his/her life.
- Be baptized in water, and filled with the Holy Spirit with the evidence of speaking in other tongues; according to the Holy scriptures and in the doctrine of LC.
- Be faithful to the church with tithes and offerings (Prov. 3:9).
- Have completed the Discovery Classes at LC, or commit to sign up for them the next time they are offered.
- Maintain a lifestyle which reflects a commitment to Christ. Due to the high visibility of platform ministry, each member should avoid any action that would bring reproach to Christ and His Church or cause the ministry of LC to be compromised. LC declares specific beliefs relative to standards of conduct and lifestyle of people in leadership positions and platform ministries.
- Be in agreement with and support of the total ministry of LC. Maintain a right spirit and positive attitude toward the Church, her leaders, and other team members. Resolve all disagreements promptly and maturely, according to God's word (Matt. 18).
- Be faithful and consistent in attendance at all practices. Pre-service practices are on Sundays at 8:00am. Team practices are held the 1st and 3rd Tuesday of each month at 7:00pm. The Director may call additional practices or change the schedule from time to time in order to meet LC or department needs.
- Be available and committed to minister in song at all regular church services, as well as any special events and performances.
- Maintain an attitude aligned with our guiding principle: "It's not about us, it's all about Him!". Members should prefer one another, working in unity to magnify the Lord Jesus Christ in praise and worship, giving all glory and honor to Him, not to ourselves.

Application and audition process for new members:

1. Helps Ministry application – submit completed forms directly to Pastor Todd.
2. Music Ministry application -- submit completed form to Herb Whitacre.
3. Audition – The audition will be scheduled after application review. It is aimed at measuring your skills for proper placement on our team, and may consist of any or all of the following:
 - a. Prepare and perform one musical piece of your choice on your instrument (or voice).
 - b. Perform other skill tests (e.g. scales, pitch matching, ad-lib) as directed.
 - c. Perform live with our team musicians.
 - d. Open discussion and interview with the Music Director.
4. Four-week commitment period – For 4 weeks, you are expected to participate in all music practices but will not perform during services. This is a time to learn the music, build friendships with team members, and demonstrate your faithfulness and positive attitude.
